Freshman Year —

Continue expanding your horizons and keep up your grades! Remember, colleges like to see an upward grade trend throughout your 4 years in high school, so if you had a rocky fall semester, it's ok! Work hard to bring those grades up in the Spring Term.

Sophomore Year —

- It's not too early for sophomores to start college planning. PREPARE FOR REGENTS EXAM (Take advantage of tutoring opportunities **SEE TUTORING SCHEDULE**). Begin considering using free online test preparation tools to prepare for the PSAT. Start researching colleges online. Set up an appropriate email account used for college admissions ONLY. Lastly, concentrate on academic and extracurricular interests.

Junior Year —

- Rising Juniors! It's January, which means preparing for your SAT is closer than ever before. **KEEP IN MIND SAT DAY IS MARCH 27TH**. Study for and take the SAT and/or ACT exams. Consider taking college-level courses (ex: AP and/or College Now). Start comparing colleges and college entrance requirements. If you don't have one already, set up an email account to use for college admissions. **KEEP IN MIND: END OF 3RD MARKING PERIOD IS JAN 18TH**

Senior Year —

- CONGRATULATIONS, YOU'RE A SENIOR! **IF YOU HAVEN'T ALREADY, SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA APPLICATION, DO IT ASAP!** Continue to apply for scholarships. It's January already, we hope you have already finished your college applications. Continue to stay focused on maintaining and increasing your GPA! Study for exams, and do your best in the upcoming January Regents!
