- Available to graduating seniors who plan to attend college in fall 2021
- Open to all U.S. citizens, Permanent Residents or students, regardless of citizenship currently attending a high school in the U.S.
- Finalists typically rank in the top 5-10% of their class, have an SAT score > 1280 or ACT > 27 and have a combined family income of \$65,000 or less per year

Gates Scholarship

- Available to high school seniors from at least one of the following ethnicities: African-American, American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian & Pacific Islander American and/or Hispanic American

- Must have a minimum 3.3 GPA (88 cumulative average)
