Albert Shanker UFT Scholarship

- Available to NYC high school seniors
- High academic standing and demonstrated leadership

- Available to high school seniors who are U.S. citizens
- Minimum 3.0 GPA (85/100) required

APIASF Scholarship

- Applicants must be of Asian and/or Pacific Islander descent and be a U.S. citizen, national or legal permanent resident
- Minimum 2.7 GPA (82/100) required

- Applicant must be a high school senior with an identified disability who plans to enroll in college for the 2020-2021 academic year
- Minimum 3.0 GPA (85/100) required

CUNY BECAS Scholarship

- Available to high school seniors who are not legal residents of the U.S.
- Must have significant financial need
- Applicants must show strong academics and service to the immigrant community
- Aids students with little/no access to financial aid.

FEBRUARY

Ascend Education Fund Scholarship

- Applicant must be born outside the U.S. or have two parents born outside the U.S.
- Must demonstrate qualities of hard work, resourcefulness, perseverance in the face of adversity, academic achievement, leadership, and commitment to one's community

Scholarship Plus

- Available to high school seniors with a strong record of community service
- Minimum 85+ GPA required
- Must have significant financial need and show success in overcoming adversity

Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship

- Available to high school seniors who plan to attend a college in the fall 2020
- Minimum scores of 1000 SAT or 21 ACT
- Must have significant financial need
- Applicants show strong leadership potential and dedication to community service

McDonald's Hacer Scholarship for Hispanic Students

- Scholarships available to high school seniors who are U.S. citizens or legal residents
- Must be of Hispanic descent (at least 1 parent)
- Must demonstrate significant financial need

National Council of Jewish Woman (NCJW) Scholarship

- Available to high school seniors who plan to attend college in fall 2020
