- Health Science combines principles of medicine, chemistry, biology, and experimental science. This field evaluates and investigates medical treatment, principles and methods, using classically designed studies under controlled conditions.
- Pre-health science programs provide guidance to students as they prepare for medical, dental, pharmacy school, and medical training.
- Students often choose to major in chemistry or biology because they must take several classes in these fields to prepare for their entrance exam into medical, dental, or pharmacy school.
