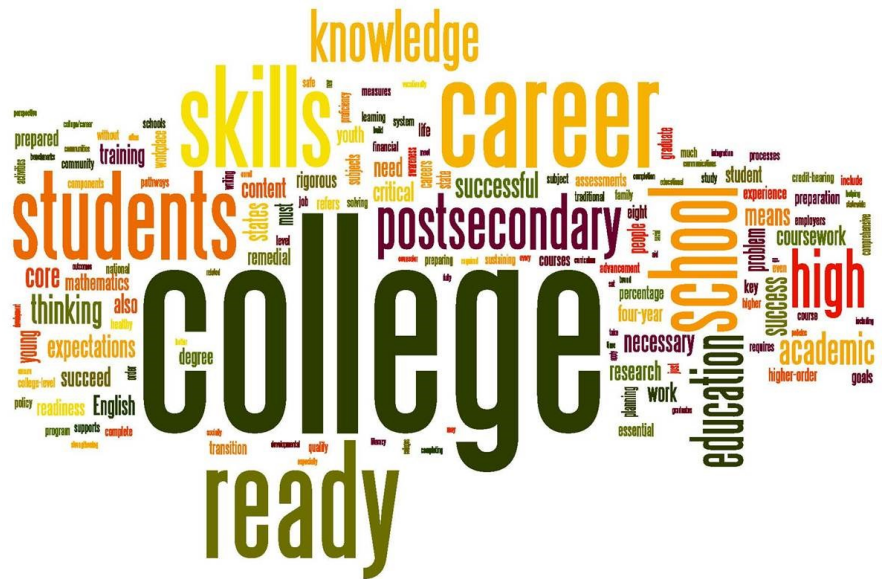

## College Planning

Remember — Decision making is a process, not an event.

To all NUHS Students & Parents out there, **#YouCanDoThis!**

### Freshman Year —

- Get involved: Stay updated with PupilPath. Study hard and do well in school — From now on your grades will count toward college and will show up on your permanent record. Get to know your high school counselor & college advisor and let them know about your goals, career aspirations, interests. **KEEP IN MIND: 3RD MARKING PERIOD HAS BEGUN**

### Sophomore Year —

- It's not too early for sophomores to start college planning. Study for and take the PSAT, treating it as a trial run. Consider using free online test preparation tools to prepare for the PSAT. Attend college-related events. Start creating your profile on free scholarship search engines, ie.Fastweb. Research colleges online. Set up an appropriate email account used for college admissions ONLY. Lastly, concentrate on academic and extracurricular interests. **KEEP IN MIND: 3RD MARKING PERIOD HAS BEGUN**

### Junior Year —

- It's December, which means preparing for your SAT is closer than ever before. Study for and take the SAT and/or ACT exams. Consider taking college-level courses (ex: AP and/or College Now). Start comparing colleges and college entrance requirements. If you don't have one already, set up an email account to use for college admissions. **KEEP IN MIND: 3RD MARKING PERIOD HAS BEGUN**

### Senior Year —

- Senior year is a pivotal time. During your senior year, we hope you will be college-bound ready. **ATTEND THE FAFSA COMPLETION NIGHT ON DEC 17TH @ 5PM, IF YOU HAVEN'T COMPLETED YOUR FAFSA APPLICATION!** You will finalize your college applications by December 1st. This year is filled with admission applications, personal statements, financial aid information and the need to meet deadlines. File for FAFSA & TAP. Continue to stay focused on maintaining and increasing your GPA!
